Student problem-solves words using:

- o beginning letter(s)/sound(s)
- o letter-sound clusters
- o blending letters/sounds
- o onset and rime
- o knowledge of spelling patterns (analogies)
- o syllables
- o rereading

Teacher Observation Guide to note what should be included in the retelling.

- o Use the prompts only if necessary to gain further information. Count the number of prompts given.
- Reflection/Making Connections Levels 4 - 16
- o Record the student's response to the questions on the Teacher Observation Guide or on the DRA2 Summary rubric.
