With the world's urban population having crossed the fifty per cent threshold of global population, it has become increasingly clear that the future is urban. The International Guidelines on Urban and Territorial Planning serve both as a source of inspiration and a compass for decision makers and urban professionals when reviewing urban and territorial planning systems. The Guidelines provide national governments, local authorities, civil society organizations and planning professionals with a global reference framework that promotes more compact, socially inclusive, better integrated and connected cities and territories that foster sustainable ... The proposed Urban Design Guidelines will serve as a tool for neighborhood groups, the public, designers, developers, planners, and the Planning Commission to establish a citywide set of expectations, goals, values, and qualities by which projects are evaluated. The Guidelines are intended only to address how a building impacts and supports the character of the existing City fabric. Urban Design, Design Review, Design Standards and Guidelines Zoning provides quantitative requirements to ensure proper placement, height, bulk and use of structures throughout the city. In designated design review districts throughout the city, development is also reviewed using discretionary design standards and guidelines to help ensure compatibility with a special context or to promote unique design objectives.
